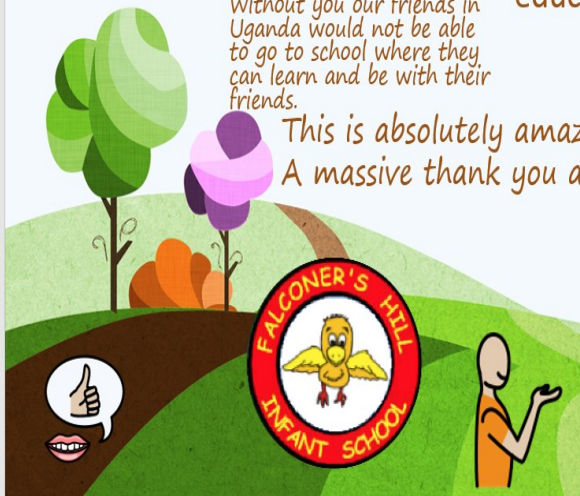
FHIS School Council Fund Raising April 2023
