<p>Drawing- a way of making a <u>picture</u>. Drawings are created by making lines on a surface eg paper..</p> <p>Portrait- a painting, drawing or photograph showing only the face or head and shoulders.</p> <p>Tone- the lightness or darkness of a colour</p> <p>Smudge- to rub, dab or swipe in a smeary manner.</p> <p>Texture- the way an object feels to the touch or looks as it may feel if it were touched</p> <p>Shading- to make an area on your picture dark or darker.</p>				<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Drawings can be images of real life or abstract images showing ideas cannot be seen in the real world. • Drawings are made with mark making tools such as a pencil, pen, charcoal, pastels or crayon rather than paint. • This term we are drawing with the inspiration from countries around the world to link with our Globe Trotters theme eg Africa • Keith Haring (Year 1) is an artist who loved drawing cartoons. He drew hundreds of drawings on New York’s subway. He used chalk to make his art. • Gakonga (year 2) is an artist who was born in a small village near Mount Kilimanjaro, Africa. He created pictures using natural materials such as plant dyes and sea shells.
