
This week we have our teaching and learning inspection from Sally Manz, where she will be reviewing our Writing and Geography curriculum.

were learning all about the 5 senses. They conducted an experiment based around sight.








23.4.24 In Science today we have learnt about our senses and carried out investigations using our sense of sight.
