
Science

History

DT: Textiles

Music

In History this term we will be learning about Captain James Cook. We will be learning about their lives and achievements.

Year 2 will also be comparing and contrasting their lives and time periods.

We will also be celebrating Grandparents Day: a chance to meet and ask questions about what their life was like and how things have changed through the years.

This term we will be focusing on Textiles.

We will know textiles are made from weaving fabrics together. We will be using a running stitch to combine fabrics together. The children will be designing and creating a bag. They will then decorate their bag using fabric glue or stitching.

In Music this term Year 2 will be expressing their feelings through music and song by inventing a musical story. Music can be loud or soft, fast or slow, smooth and connected, or short and detached. We can also use instruments with different sounds to help communicate a story and different emotions. Children will explore music to connect their feelings to what they hear

Some children in Year 2 will also be taking part in the Big Sing with other schools in the academy to perform in a choir. As part of this they will be learning a variety of songs and sign language.

PSHE

This term we will be looking at 'Keeping safe'

We will be thinking about how we would feel in different situations and what to do if something makes us feel unsafe. We will be learning about keeping secrets and when it is appropriate. We will also think about who are safe adults are and how we can approach them with our worries.
