







## FHIS Spring term 1 – Weather and Seasons

<b>Key Vocabulary</b>		<b>Important Facts</b>	
<p><b>Climate-</b> the weather conditions for a period of time.</p> <p><b>Country-</b> a nation with it's own government.</p> <p><b>Weather-</b> The term "weather" refers to the temporary conditions of the atmosphere, the layer of air that surrounds the Earth.</p> <p><b>Seasons-</b> A season is a period of the year that is distinguished by special climate conditions. The four seasons—spring, summer, fall, and winter—follow one another regularly.</p> <p><b>Weather forecast-</b> Weather forecasting is the prediction of what the atmosphere will be like in a particular place by using technology and scientific knowledge to make weather observations. In other words, it's a way of predicting things like cloud cover, rain, snow, wind speed, and temperature before they happen.</p>		<p>The weather describes how hot, cold, wet, dry, calm, stormy, clear or cloudy it is in a place.</p> <p>The weather can be different in different places at the same time.</p> <p>Spring, Summer, Autumn and Winter are the 4 seasons of the year.</p> <p>Uganda is a hot country reaching temperatures. Weather in Uganda is hot, dry and humid.</p> <p>The temperature is shown by numbers.</p> <p>There is a North and South pole.</p> <p>The equator is the 'invisible' red line that goes around the middle of the earth.</p> <p>The Arctic is located at the northernmost part of Earth Winter temperatures can drop below <math>-50^{\circ}\text{C}</math>. Polar bears live in the Arctic, near the North Pole</p>
